Roles and Responsibilities of the Anti-Ragging Committee:

1. To ensure compliance with the provision of UGC regulation 2009 at the institution level.
2. To conduct awareness program among the students on anti-ragging by displaying anti-ragging posters issued by Commissioner of Police/ APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University/Listing all the actionable Laws and their consequences, to keep a close watch on all such activities and counsel them if necessary.
3. To advise the girl students to be in continuous communication with the parents, principal and the faculty members with regard to any sort of ragging.
4. To monitor and oversee the performance of anti-ragging squad in prevention of ragging in the institution.
5. Anti ragging Squad- To be nominated by the head of the institute with the representation as may be considered necessary from the campus community only.

6. To make surprise raids in girls and boys common rooms and other places vulnerable to incidents of and having the potential of ragging.
7. To conduct on the spot enquiry in to any incident of ragging.
8. The committee will also maintain alert vigil at all times and ensure that the Anti ragging squads of the institution carry out their functions properly.
9. Keep close watch on the visitors of non-students/strangers in the college campus.
10. Organize meeting with students especially with girls to advise them to regulate their own movements and interactions, especially with strangers or undesirable characters.
11. Advise the girl students to avoid emotional relationships of any sort with male students about whose background they have limited knowledge and also advise them about the Do's and Don'ts.
12. If any type of ragging is occurred, immediately conduct the meeting and recommend appropriate action to be taken as per the Act of prohibition of ragging in Educational Institutions (26 of 1997) to the concerned authorities. Conduct Committee meeting frequently and discuss day to day situations in the campus and inform to the higher authorities.
13. Create peaceful and ragging free atmosphere in the college campus/surroundings.

ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

Ragging is strictly banned in Sainik Pharmacy College. If anybody found indulge in such kind of activities, strict action will be taken irrespective of the extent of the act. Ragging is banned by the Supreme Court of India. In order to prevent such kind of activity in campus, an anti-ragging committee has been formed is operational even before the start of First year classes by the Director.

SAY NO TO RAGGING

Ragging is neither a means of familiarization, nor an introduction with fresher's, but a form of psychopathic behavior. Ragging is a violation of Human Rights. Respect for Humanitarian Values. Ragging is a heinous crime, heavily punishable under the law. Ragging may spoil your career forever.

FOLLOWING BEHAVIOUR WITH FRESHERS IS TANTAMOUNT TO RAGGING:

- Force students to address seniors as 'Sir '
- Force students to perform mass drills.
- Force students to copy class notes for the seniors.
- Force students to run various errands.
- Force students to do menial jobs for the seniors.
- Force students to ask/answer vulgar questions.
- Force students to watch pornographic pictures
- Force students to drink alcohol, scalding tea, smoking, etc.
- Force students to perform acts which can lead to physical injury/ mental torture or death
- Force students to perform acts with sexual overtones, including homosexual acts.

PUNITIVE MEASURES FOR RAGGING

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the College, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging shall be one or any combination of the following:

- Cancellation of admission.
- Suspension from attending classes.
- Debarring from any test/examination or any other evaluation process
- Collective punishment when individuals committing or abetting ragging are not identified.
- Rigorous imprisonment and fine up to Rs. 2.5 lakhs as per Law.
